Summary: On the campuses of the **Los Rios Community College District**, Sacramento State and other area colleges, more than half of the enrolling students register for remedial classes in math, reading or writing. In March, business, education and community leaders will officially launch a new approach called Align Capital Region, an alignment model designed to engage the community by leveraging assets and resources in a way that achieves systemic, generational change.
