Title: Rookie DT Jordan Carrell fighting for more than just Cowboys roster spot after tragically losing his father

Summary: If Lawrence Carrell were here now, he'd be sneaking around The Star in Frisco. Jordan Carrell, whom the Cowboys drafted with their final selection (246th overall) in April, says his dad would be ecstatic. Jumping up and down even.

Coach Mike MacIntyre's relationship with his players had swayed Carrell to Colorado after two years at junior college. He thrived at Sacramento's **American River College**, becoming a JuCo All-American and the league's defensive player of the year with an 80-tackle, eight-sack sophomore year. He racked up 19 tackles for loss, 24 quarterback hurries, two pass break-ups and a forced fumble that season.
