Title: “Poetry in Motion:” Pacific Chamber Orchestra Begins 29th Season

Summary: The Pacific Chamber Orchestra, Lawrence Kohl conducting, opens its 29th season at the Bankhead Theater on Sunday September 17 at 2:00 pm. The concert, “Poetry in Motion,” takes the audience on a lyrical journey through Mozart’s overture to the opera *The Abduction from the Seraglio*, Beethoven’s Piano Concerto #4 with pianist Natsuki Fukasawa and Schubert’s Symphony #1 in D Major.

Fulbright scholar and Steinway Artist Natsuki Fukasawa’s career has taken her throughout the U.S., Europe, Israel, Australia, Brazil, Japan and China, performing at Carnegie Hall, Kennedy Center and Copenhagen’s Tivoli Concert Hall. Fukasawa has won many international prizes, rave reviews in *Strad* and *Fanfare* magazines and the Best Chamber Music Recording of the Year from the Danish Music Awards. She serves on the artist faculty of the Talis Festival & Academy in Saas-Fee, Switzerland and Italy’s Orfeo Music Festival. She is currently on faculty at **American River College** and has taught at CSU Sacramento, Saint Mary’s College and the University of the Pacific. She earned her Bachelor and Master’s degrees from Juilliard, and Doctorate from the University of Maryland. She has recorded for the Classico and Da Capo labels.

High near Roseville, Paulhus had a few Division II scholarship offers but nothing from the FCS or FBS level, so he went to **American River College** in Sacramento and recorded 166 tackles and five sacks in two seasons.
