Summary: Chris has no recollection of Mexico, besides photos of his grandfather's dog and where his family lived before they came here 16 years ago, when he was 5. Today he's a 21-year-old alumnus of Oakmont High School, double-majoring at **American River College** and hoping to transfer to Sacramento State.

"I want to work for the city if I can," he said.

Depending on Congressional action in coming months, Chris — who asked that his full name not be used — may not have the chance to pursue his goals, along with roughly 800,000 other immigrants brought to the United States illegally as children.
