**Summary:** The NCAA's new early signing period in college football has made things more hectic for coaches this season, but the Wolf Pack staff has maneuvered the hurdles and is expected to sign at least 17 players Wednesday on the first day recruits can sign binding letters of intent.

Moses Landis, from Sacramento's **American River College**, will join the team in January and vie for an immediate starting role as offensive lineman.

Kaleb Meder, a 6-foot-3, 250-pound defensive lineman, finalizes the defensive group. As a junior-college transfer, he will join the Wolf Pack in January and take part in spring camp.

Four **American River College** players signed, each a critical piece to a Beavers team that reached the Northern California championship game and finished ranked sixth nationally by JCGridwire.com. Two were offensive linemen: Diego Cervantes of Elk Grove with Old Dominion and Moses Landis of El Camino with Nevada. Defensive tackle Kaleb Meder of Wheatland signed with Nevada. Defensive back Lenny Nelson of Woodcreek signed with North Dakota State of the Big Sky Conference.

Christian MacFarland, an ARC defensive back and former member of the Cosumnes Oaks Wolfpack, signed with Idaho State.

The NorCal runner-up Beavers will need to do some recruiting with so many guys moving on to the next level, but knowing recruiting coordinator Ryan "Scooter" Gomes, that won't be an issue. Plenty of talent around our area who want to play at ARC next season.
